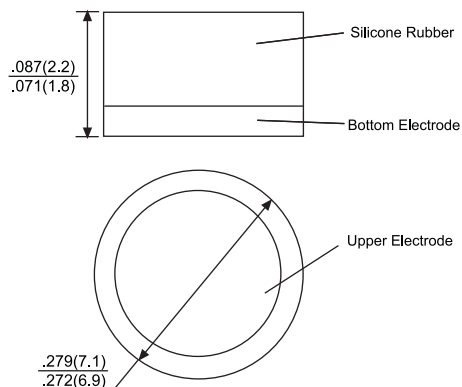

FIG.1 - FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

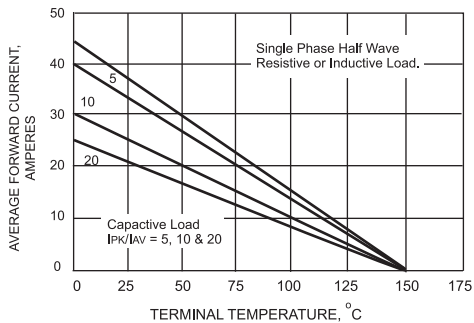


FIG.2 - NON - REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

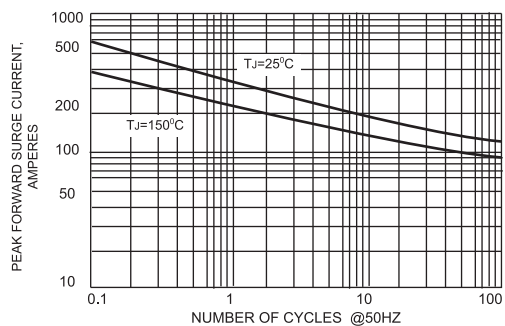


FIG.3 - FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

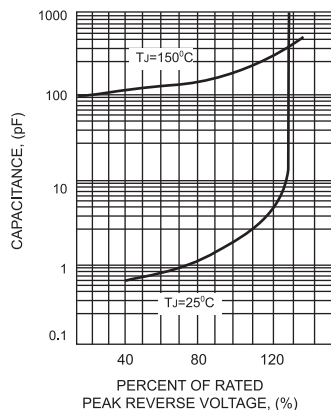


FIG.4 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

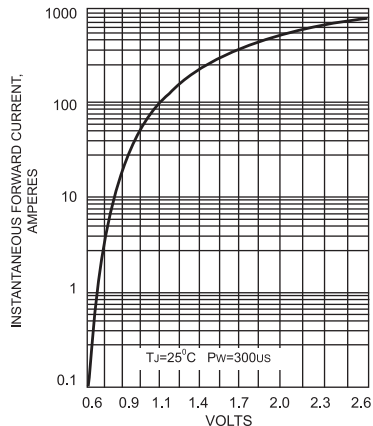


FIG.5 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
